Grooming Sedation / Stripping Release Form

If your pet's vaccine history is not verifiably current, your pet will receive all mandatory vaccines.

Every effort will be made to groom your pet without sedation. If sedation is required because of the behavior of the cat, there will be an additional fee for sedation:

Pre-Anesthetic Screening Consent: (additional cost)

For the enhanced protection of our patients, we recommend pre-sedation screening of all pets prior to administration of anesthetics. Although we do perform a pre-sedation exam, many conditions (including disorders of the kidneys, liver and blood) cannot be detected without blood lab screening. We highly recommend pre-sedation screening before sedating your pet.

Stripping Release

It has been our experience that when a cat is "shaved down" or "stripped" pre-existing conditions may appear. When a cat is very matted, air can not get through to it's skin. If the cat has an itch and bites itself, the skin will become sore and will not be able to heal through it's matted coat. Stripping uncovers these skin conditions, as well as other skin problems that may have developed from the lack of air and grooming. Please note that it is difficult to strip a matted cat without slightly irritating the skin, since we must get underneath the mats.
